

**REGULATIONS OF THE EVENT held under the name:
"Oleśnica's Festival of Circus and Art"**

In order to ensure safety of participants of the event, we hereby introduce these Regulations (hereinafter referred to as: the "**Regulations**"), worded as follows:

1. The regulations, issued by the Organiser, i.e. by the "OFCA Foundation" with its registered office at ul. Sejmowa 1/5, 56-400 Oleśnica, KRS 559954, NIP 9112010907 (hereinafter referred to as: the "**Organiser**"), referring to the event held under the name: "**Oleśnica's Festival of Circus and Art**", which will be held from 10 to 12 August 2018 in Oleśnica (hereinafter referred to as: the "**Festival**").
The Regulations aims at ensuring safety of participants of the Festival by defining the rules of behaviour of the persons present.

2. The Regulations are addressed to all the persons who will be staying at the Festival venue during the Festival. Therefore, any person staying in this area during the event is obliged to comply with the provisions of these Regulations.

3. The events taking place during the Festival are free (for some events, the audience members may need a free admission ticket). Payable admission ticket is only required for campsite and highlines.

4. Tickets are only sold at the registration point located at the Oleśnica Castle at the opening hours. When purchasing tickets, a purchaser should have and show an ID.

5. After purchasing an entry ticket for both the campsite and highlines, participants of the Festival will be provided with a wristband in the appropriate colour, which entitles them to enter the campsite or a highline (different colours for participants of the campsite and those using highlines). Participants may each time enter the campsite or a highline if they have unbroken wristbands fixed securely on their wrists.

6. Participants who are under 18 years of age may participate in the Festival on the basis of the consent of a legal guardian submitted during registration at the Festival information point.

7. If the Festival participant is under 16 years of age, they may participate in the Festival only under the care of an adult, who at the first entrance to the Festival in the information point will sign the declaration of responsibility for the minor.

8. The Organiser may refuse entry into the campsite and highlines to persons who have not registered at the Festival information point and do not have a valid band, or do not want to show the band at the entrance.

9. Participants of the Festival and all other persons remaining at the venue are obliged to behave in a way that does not threaten safety of other persons present at the Festival. It is forbidden to destroy equipment located at the Festival venue. Participants of the Festival and all other persons who are at its venue are obliged to follow the instructions of the Organiser and Security Service.

10. The Security Service of the Festival or the Organiser may remove from the Festival venue those who disturb public order or behave in a way which violates the Regulations.

11. The Organiser may refuse to admit to the Festival:

- a) persons under visible influence of alcohol, intoxicants, psychotropic drugs or other similar agents,
- b) a person with weapons or other dangerous objects, explosives, pyrotechnic materials, fire hazardous materials, alcoholic beverages, intoxicants or psychotropic substances,
- c) a person behaving aggressively, provocatively or otherwise threatening safety.

12. The Organiser ensures safety and order to persons present at the Festival through, among others:

- a) ensuring Security Service during the Festival in designated places, especially at the campsite, from 10:00 pm to 10:00 am,
- b) providing medical help points,
- c) informing the Police and Fire Brigade on the organized Festival and cooperation in terms of security,

13. It is forbidden to conduct, without the consent of the Organiser, any commercial or other economic activity, as well as advertising and promotional activities at the venue of the Festival.

14. The Organiser is not liable for any damage or health impairment that may result from participation in the Festival, incurred by both the participant and a third party. The participant bears full liability.

15. The Organiser of the event is not liable for the objects left at the venue of the Festival by its participants and other persons remaining at the venue of the Festival.

16. The Organiser is not liable for the effects of force majeure.

17. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or shorten the Festival as well as implement changes to the program without prior notice, especially in case of weather breakdown or equipment failure.

18. In case of disputes the Organiser has a casting and final vote.

19. Participation in the Festival has the same effect as granting consent for recording, photographing or making other types of records and using the image of the participant for the purposes of publication on the websites, written publications and Organiser's promotional materials.

20. Participants of the campsite and users of highline are also subject to other relevant Regulations, such as Campsite Regulations, OFCA Slackline Regulations and the Open Stage Fire Show Regulations.
