

Campsite Regulations for participants of the "OFCA" Festival 2018

1. These Regulations apply at the Campsite organized for "Oleśnica's Festival of Circus and Art" outside the walls of the Oleśnica Castle on 10-13 August 2018, hereinafter referred to as the Campsite.
2. The Campsite is open from 6:00 pm on Thursday, August 9th to 12 pm Monday, August 13th 2018.
3. The use of the Campsite is charged and costs 50 PLN. It is a fee per one person, for the whole time when the Campsite is organised.
4. Participants who are under 18 years of age may participate in the Festival on the basis of the consent of a legal guardian submitted during registration at the Festival information point.
5. If the Festival participant is under 16 years of age, they may participate in the Festival only under the care of an adult, who at the first entrance to the Festival in the information point will sign the declaration of responsibility for the minor.
6. Person remaining at the Campsite must wear wristbands. The wristbands are given out at the registration point at the Castle after paying a fee and signing a statement about reading the Campsite Regulations.
7. The participant of the Campsite with a wristband may use showers and toilets located in the Oleśnica Castle without extra charge.
8. Entrance to the area of the Campsite is only allowed for persons with wristbands and persons authorized by the Organiser.
9. Admission to the Campsite is forbidden to:
 - persons who do not have the required bands,
 - persons under influence of alcohol and intoxicants,
 - persons who have been prevented from entry to the Campsite for safety reasons by a security guard.
10. Campsite does not accept cars, motorcycles or caravans vehicles. The Campsite only accepts tents and camper.
11. Entering and staying at the Campsite means full acceptance of the Regulations.
12. At the entrance to the Campsite, the participants are obliged to present a wristband authorising them to enter the Campsite.
13. At the Campsite it is not allowed to:
 - make bonfires,
 - have barbecue,
 - use open fire in tents,
 - use gas cylinders,
 - devastate infrastructure and interfere in any way in the surrounding greenery,
 - disturb order,
 - litter the area,
 - bring items that may threaten safety of participants (e.g. firearms, firecrackers, knuckledusters, clubs, smoke candles, knives).
 - bring and consume alcohol, intoxicants and psychotropic substances,
 - bring animals (exception: dogs – necessarily on leash, with a muzzle),
 - conduct any commercial, advertising, acquisition and cash collection activities without the Organiser's consent,
 - satisfy physiological needs outside the toilets.
14. The Participants are forbidden to destroy and devastate the equipment at the Campsite and to dig holes and canals around the tents. In case of doing the above, the Participants are obliged to restore the original state.
15. Persons who do not comply with the above mentioned Regulations will be expelled from the Campsite without any possibility of return.
16. The Organiser is not liable for lost or stolen valuable items.
17. The Participant is obliged to follow all instructions of the Organiser and security service.
18. The Organiser is not liable for damages and accidents of participants at the Campsite.
19. In case of disputes concerning matters not regulated by these Regulations, the decision is taken by the Organiser's representative.
